Our Congregation's membership has decreased in numbers and increased in age.

The Nominating Committee has given careful consideration and prayer about the committee's recommendation to Session for the following;

- Reduce the congregational quorum from 20% to 10%.
- Reduce the number of Elders from nine to six beginning with the Class of 2025.

The Congregation quorum reduction and Elder reduction requires a called Congregational Meeting which will be October 6, 2024. Two church bulletins September 22 and September 29 will advertise the Congregational Meeting. If the congregation approves the recommendations, the request will require the approval of Presbytery under the provisions of the Book of Order.
